Code of Ethics for Organizations Working with Donors

Promoting common interest of developing sovereign and free civil society, we declare that:

1. Received donations will be used in line with our mission and the will of a donor, whether expressed in writing or orally. If we know we are unable to use donation in this way, we will reject it.
2. We inform openly, truthfully and completely about all received donations.
3. We are responsible from whom we accept donations and we govern ourselves by principles openly communicated.
4. Received donations are used efficiently, economically and in accordance with applicable legislation.
5. We use tools for enhancing transparency, in particular, we disclose our bylaws (statute, establishing document), annual report, financial statements or audit of economic performance, etc.
6. We always thank for a donation and guarantee that the acquired data on donors will be treated confidentially and securely in accordance with the law on personal data protection.
7. We guarantee that persons designated to act on our behalf with donors and mobilize their interest and support will follow the code of ethics of fundraisers.

Code of Ethics for Fundraisers

1. All communication of a fundraiser with a donor is open, truthful and complete.
2. Fundraiser respects both the donor and his/her refusal, shall not misuse weakness of the donor, and shall not blackmail emotionally or create pressure.
3. Fundraiser approaches only those donors who are acceptable for the organization.
4. Fundraiser accepts only such a donation that is intended to be used in line with the mission and ethical rules of the organization.
5. Fundraiser acts with aim not to damage the organization, its reputation or damage other organizations.
6. Fundraiser thanks always, on time and in an adequate manner.
7. Fundraiser protects dignity, safety and rights of people, for whom the organization implements its activities.
8. Fundraiser is educating him-/herself in the field and strives to cultivate the fundraiser's profession.
